Regulation

1. Registrations

REGISTRATION FEE

- For **single free skating competition** judged with White system the fee is set at € 13,00 for athlete.
- For **single free skating competition** judged with RollArt system the fee is set at € 20,00 for athlete
- For **artistic pairs and dance couples competition** judged with White system the fee is set at € 15,00 for couple.
- For **dance couples competition** judged with RollArt system the fee is set at € 25,00 for couple.

Registrations received up to the capacity of the individual categories will be accepted (especially for categories judged with RollArt) based on the organization of the Trophy, also considering the Fisr Guidelines for Covid-19.

Registrations arriving after the deadline will be evaluated at the discretion of the organizing club.

Any **deletions** must be received by **05th June 2022**. The draw for entry order will take place on 06th June at 18:00 at the sports facility.

For deletions communicated after the draw, and not duly justified, the registration fee must be paid in any case, unless otherwise assessed by the organizing club.

- Categories judged according to the WorldSkate Regulation with **White System**:
Cadets, Jeunesse, Junior, Senior

DANCE COUPLES

There is **ONLY the Free dance** (no Style dance or compulsory)

- Categories judged according to the FISR Regulation with **White System**:
Tots, Minis, Promotional minis, Promotional espoir,
Promotional Cadet/Jeunesse/Junior/Senior
- Categories judged according to the WordSkate Regulation with **RollArt System**:
Espoir, Cadets, Jeunesse, Junior, Senior

Each category is further divided into 6 groups: **CLASSIC, EXCELLENT, MASTER, COMPETITIVE, PROFESSIONAL, EXPERT.**

(For example, you have Category: Cuccioli Classic, Cuccioli Excellent, etc...)

Males and females compete in separate categories.

TECHNICAL REGULATION PROMOTIONAL CATEGORIES

For all the categories, judged with White System, the duration of the program will be:

- ✓ 2 minutes +/- 10 seconds for Classic, Excellent, Master, Competitive, Professional groups
- ✓ 2 minutes and 30 seconds +/- 10 seconds for Expert group.

If the music tracks are longer than the maximum term, the music assistant will fade the track at 2.10 min or 2.40 min depending on the category.

TABLE OF MANDATORY EXERCISES

(exercises that will contribute to the assignment of the score. Further added difficulties will not be evaluated or penalized).

- **CLASSIC GROUP**
 - Bend on 2 legs 0.8
 - Balanced with one leg bent forward 0.9
 - Jump on 2 feet without rotation and with ½ rotation (Max 2 sequences with max 5 jumps) 1.7
 - Slalom on one or two feet 1.2
 - Skating forward 0.8
 - Musicality 0.6
 - Total: 6.0

- **EXCELLENT GROUP**
 - Spin on two feet (min. 2 rotations) 0.9
 - Bend on one leg with the other leg stretched forward (sit position) 0.7
 - Series of 3 jumps of ½ rotation; the last jump must exit in backward outside edge 1.2
 - Waltz Jump (Max 2 sequences with max 3 jumps) 1.8
 - Skating forward and backward 0.8
 - Musicality 0.6
 - Total: 6.0

- **MASTER GROUP**
 - Inside backward vertical spin (min. 2 rotations) 1.0
 - Camel position 0.9
 - Waltz jump, Toeloop e Salchow; single jumps and combination (Max 3 combo of 3 jumps) 2.0
 - Three outside forward 0.7
 - Footwork (optionally if diagonal, circle, serpentine) 0.8
 - Musicality 0.6
 - Total: 6.0

- **COMPETITIVE GROUP**
 - Inside backward vertical spin (min. 3 rotations) 1.0
 - Camel position 0.9
 - 1 rotation jumps until Lutz (max 3 jumps – no Thoren – no Rit)
Also in combination (Max 3 combinations of 3 jumps) 2.0
 - Camel forward position 0.7
 - Footwork (optionally if diagonal, circle, serpentine) 0.8
 - Musicality 0.6
 - Total: 6.0

- **PROFESSIONAL GROUP**
 - Inside backward vertical spin (min. 3 rotations) 0.9
 - 1 rotation jumps; single jumps and combination (Max 3 combo of 3 jumps) 2.5
 - Camel position 0.7
 - Footwork (optionally if diagonal, circle, serpentine) 0.8
 - Spread eagles 0.6
 - Musicality 0.5
 - Total: 6.0

- **EXPERT GROUP**
 - 1 rotation jumps and Axel: single jumps and combination (Max 3 combo of 5 jumps) 1.8
 - Double Salchow **or** double Toeloop (only single jump, max 2 repetitions) 1.0
 - Single sit spins (min. 3 rotations) 1.3
 - Combinations vertical spins, min. 2 rotations for each spin (max 2 combination spins) 1.5
 - Footwork (optionally if diagonal, circle, serpentine) 0.8
 - Combination of camel positions on any edge, also with change of foot 0.6
 - Total: 7.0

3. Evaluation method

Compatibly with the availability of the jury and the feasibility of the event according to Fisr Guidelines for Covid-19, the categories will be judged with the White and RollArt systems as indicated in paragraph 2.

4. Club Points and Trophy Award

For each category and for each competition program done, for the purposes of awarding the Trophy, the following scores are assigned:

1 st classified	16 points	10 points
2 nd classified	14 points	8 points
3 rd classified	12 points	6 points
4 th classified	10 points	4 points
5 th classified	8 points	3 points
6 th classified	5 points	2 points
From 7 th classified	2 points	1 point

If the participants are less than or equal to 5 the points are halved.

The ranking will be drawn up on the basis of the sum of the scores obtained from the top ten best scores of each belonging team. The trophy will be awarded to the club that has achieved the highest score.

In the event of a tie, the team will win with a prevalence of: a) first places - b) second places - c) third places - d) team with the youngest athlete.

The organizing club does not participate in the awarding of the Trophy.

5. Various

The Jury is designated by **the C.U.G.**

Athletes will be awarded with **cups and/or medals** and each athlete will receive a **gadget** during registration.

The competitions will be organized on the **internal skating ring** (parquet 20 x 40 meters). The external skating ring (quartz 27 x 52 meters) remains available for trainings.

Medical assistance will be guaranteed throughout the event.

Protocols for the containment of Covid-19 will be activated on the basis of the regulations in force at the date of the competition.

The organizing club declines any responsibility before, after and during the sporting event. Any forms and anomalies that cannot be resolved by interpreting these regulations will be resolved by an unquestionable decision by the President of the Jury at the beginning of the current day's competitions for an ethical and correct conduct of the competition.
